

One in five people diagnosed with HIV in NSW are heterosexual and many of them are diagnosed late which means they are often unwell. 2016 in review

Australians in 2015 (based on data from the Annual Surveillance Report 2016)




Disclosure laws set to be erased...

Section 79 of the Public Health Act are likely to be dropped. The NSW Premier has stated that legislation will go through in 2017. People with HIV in NSW will no longer have to disclose before sex, if they are taking reasonable precautions such as using condoms, being on medication and have an undetectable viral load. The law will be more like Victoria where any two people having sex have a mutual responsibility to protect themselves.
